## Sleepers Hill Association - Ballot paper

Traffic calming scheme involving the installation of four speed tables on the upper part of Sleepers Hill, (subject to the final approval of the authorities and the firm agreement of the "road owners" concerned) at an estimated overall cost of £15,000.

The estimate of £15,000 is based on the lowest quotation, best estimates of the cost of obligatory signs and lighting, consultants' fees for the supervision of construction work and Value Added Tax (see Item 7 of the AGM Minutes).

It was agreed at the Sleepers Hill Association AGM held on 6 February 2000 that the criterion for proceeding with this scheme should be that at least 75% of subscribing members of the Association (one per household), i.e. 60 out of a total of 80, are in favour and are willing to pay an equal share of the cost (estimated to amount to 1/60th of £15,000, i.e. £250\*, per household), the vote being by postal ballot.

\*If any increase in the overall estimate would cause the individual share to exceed £300, members will again be consulted before any work is allowed to proceed.
